The first step in the pathway to competitive cricket. All equipment is provided by ASJCC, with soft balls and small light bats, shortened pitches and basic cricket rules. All kids get to have a bat and bowl and their first experience of cricket as a true team sport. Training commences in September 2021, with Friday night matches commencing shortly after. Boys and girls of all ages welcome.

Training commences in September 2021, with Friday night matches commencing shortly after. Boys and girls of all ages welcome.

#### **COVID SAFE CRICKET IN SEASON 2021/22**

There is no doubt the summer of cricket has taken a new shape; the Coronavirus pandemic has altered the landscape of cricket in 2021/22. One thing is for certain - ASJCC has the safety of all its players and family members at the forefront and we will not compromise it in any way.

The Committee has worked incredibly hard over the off-season to ensure all safety protocols are in place and meet the Victorian Government and Cricket Victoria standards, as well as those passed down by the North Western Metropolitan Cricket Association (NWMCA).

Contact tracing will be completed via a QR code that has been specifically set for the club to track who has attended training sessions. It is compulsory for all attendees to check in at each session. Upon arrival, scan the QR code via your smart phone and enter your details.

Please note that strict privacy restrictions are in place and records are automatically deleted every 28 days.
